Acting for the Camera

July 20-24, 9-11 AM

Anne Mulhall, owner of LDI Casting will teach students how to create a character, improvise scenes and work with scripts all whilst being filmed. The scenes are later watched by the group and critiqued.

Art Around the World

July 27 -31, 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM

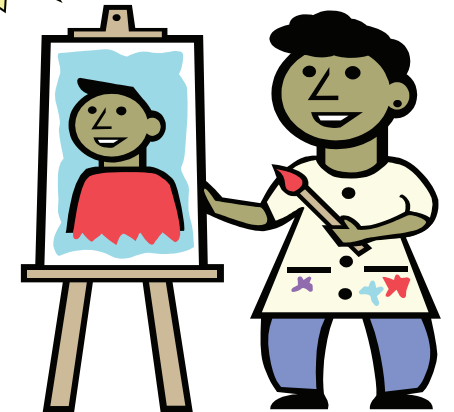
